

Frequently Asked Questions

How do I apply for the grant?

Eligible sub-applicants will be asked to complete the consent agreement found on our website. Once the consent agreement is signed the eligible sub-applicant will be included in the cybersecurity capability assessment and may be eligible to receive services or funds through the SLCGP based on identified gaps. A project application form and procedure is under development and will be made available on this website.

When is the deadline to apply for FY2022 SLCGP funds?

Eligible sub-applicants may participate in the Federal Fiscal Year 22 (FFY22) SLCGP project areas by having their authorized official or representative sign the consent agreement. Completed consent agreements should be returned to cybergrant@delaware.gov. The FFY23 SLCGP application window will open in the coming months. The DTI SLCGP webpage will be updated as FY23 information becomes available.

How much money will I receive if awarded?

The SLCGP will provide services or funds to eligible subrecipients once the cyber assessment is completed. Interested eligible sub-applicants will need to complete a project application form and provide documentation to support funding requests.

What if I want all or only some of the services/resources offered?

Eligible sub-applicants must sign the consent agreement and take part in the assessment before requesting services or funds. Entities can obtain one, some, or all of the offered projects, based on their cybersecurity risk. There is no obligation to accept all the services and resources; applicants may pick and choose.

What if I am not 100% confident in some of my answers on the SLCGP assessment, or am not sure which services I can receive based on my current cybersecurity program?

The SLCGP assessment will act as a baseline of information necessary for the Delaware SLCGP Committee to determine your interest and the capabilities in certain areas of your current cybersecurity program. The eligible entity reserves the right to deny services or resources as needed. Please answer the questions to the best of your ability.

When will I know if I am getting services/funds?

At the conclusion of the assessment, the Delaware SLCGP Planning Committee will prioritize projects that address areas of greatest risk in an effort to support eligible sub-applicants meet a statewide baseline cyber posture.
