



SPECIAL CYBER TRAINING EDITION



Annual Cyber Security training for State and K-12 employees is changing for 2021. For the first time, employees will have the chance to "test out" of the full cyber security training program by successfully completing a short cyber security assessment test. If you successfully complete the assessment by September 15, you are exempt from the mandatory training. Check out the details below:

CYBER ASSESSMENT LAUNCHES AUGUST 25

- State and K-12 employees will receive an email on August 25, 2021 with a link to the assessment test. The test will reside at id.delaware.gov.
- The assessment test contains 23 cyber security questions. You must accurately answer 15 questions for successful completion. If this criteria is not met, you will receive an email with your training assignment soon after completing the assessment.
- If you do not complete the assessment successfully by September 15, 2021, you will be required to complete the mandatory cyber security training.
- Employees will be notified via email on September 16, 2021 if they are required to take the mandatory training. If you do not receive an email you will have successfully completed the assessment and no further action is required on your part.
- Mandatory cyber security training must be completed within 60 days of notification.

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
