Diane has also held the role of an Infrastructure Service Delivery Director managing a team of Database Administrators, Server Administrators, and Service Delivery Managers supporting the infrastructure for multiple Card Services IT and business managed applications. Service Delivery includes oversight for production support, incident and problem management, infrastructure maintenance, refreshes, and implementations. Technologies supported by Diane's Database Administrators and Server Administrators teams include Oracle, DB2, SQL, Windows, UNIX and Linux.

In her more than 22 years at Chase, Diane has managed the technology organizations supporting Production Assurance, Disaster Recovery, Performance testing and centralized IT Quality Assurance and Testing. Additionally, she formerly managed the centralized IT Program Office and Change Management teams. Diane moved to Technology from the Accounting and Finance department, where she started her Chase career in 1995. Before joining Chase, Diane was an auditor for Price Waterhouse, LLC, supporting mutual fund and real estate clients in New York and Philadelphia.
